ADMISSION TEST TO POST GRADUATION IN DENTAL AND MEDICAL COURSES – 2010

In pursuance of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of P.A. Inamdar V/s State of Maharashtra and others 2005 (6) SCC 537, Association of Private Dental and Medical Colleges will be conducting an Entrance Test which is fair, transparent and non-exploitative. Thus under the supervision of Admissions and Fee Regulatory Committee Pre- PG- DMAT- Examination 2010 is being conducted for admission. CET (Pre-PG-DMAT-2010) shall be subject to the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in C.A. No. 4060/2009 and similar connected C.As.

POST GRADUATION COURSES MEDICAL (MD/MS)

As per the aforesaid judgement the NRI quota is prescribed upto 15% of the total sanctioned seats of the colleges. Admission against these seats will be granted by the college where the candidate has applied. The admission will be based on the merit of BDS/MBBS Degree from a Institute which is recognized by the DCI/MCI. If the NRI seats are not filled up such seats shall be considered as vacant/drop out seats and shall be filled up in terms of merit secured in Pre - PG-DMAT-2010.

1. PREAMBLE

Entrance Test Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 for admission to Post Graduation Courses MDS seats in Modern Dental College & Research Centre, Gandhi Nagar, Indore, People's College of Dental Sciences & Research Centre, Bhanpur, Bhopal and Post Graduation Courses (MD/MS) in R.D. Gardi Medical College, Ujjain is being conducted by the Association of Private Dental and Medical Colleges of Madhya Pradesh.

The information brochure of Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 contains application form for the Entrance Test Pre-PG-DMAT 2010. It also contains rules for admission and information about the colleges.

- The admission committee will issue necessary instructions for implementation of these rules and provide information to be published and communicated.
 - The results of Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 will be declared only after due approval of Admission Committee.
 - The admission committee shall decide on all representations, queries, complaints etc of the candidates and the decision of the committee shall be final and binding.
 - **Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 shall be conducted under the guidance and supervision of Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee for Professional Institutions (Medical).**

3. (A). **CONDUCT OF ENTRANCE TEST MDS -2010**

3.1 **Syllabus: - Four years BDS Course.**

Subjects:-

- (a) **Medical** – General Human Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry.
Pharmacology.
General Pathology and Microbiology.
General Medicine and Surgery.
- (b) **Dentistry** - Oral & Dental Anatomy, Histology & Pathology,
Prosthodontics, Conservative & Restorative Dentistry
Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Periodontics, Orthodontics
Pedodontics, Oral Medicine, Diagnosis & Radiology
and Community Dentistry.

3. (B). **CONDUCT OF ENTRANCE TEST MD/MS -2010**

3.2 **Syllabus: - Four and Half years MBBS Course.**

Subjects:-

- (a) Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine, Community Medicine
 - (b) General Medicine Dermatology Venereology and Leprosy, General Surgery, Anaesthesiology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Oto-Rhino-Laryngology, Paediatrics, Psychiatry, Radio-diagnosis, T.B. Chest
- 3.3 Candidates should go through the contents of this brochure carefully and for any clarification and genuine doubts / difficulties, approach the admission committee.
- 3.4 Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 will be conducted at Indore city. If due to unforeseen circumstances during the conduct of Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 at the Centre and in the contingencies like incidence of mass copying, leakage of Question Paper, entrance of unauthorized persons in the examination centre/hall natural calamities, riots, etc. the Admission Committee may cancel the examination and examination would be re-conducted on a later date at the earliest.

- 3.5 All questions are compulsory hence the candidate is expected to attempt all 200 questions. Out of four bubbles provided against each question on the **OMR answer sheet**, the candidates will have to darken only one bubble by using **Black Ball pen** for each correct answer one mark will be awarded.
- 3.6 There shall be no negative marking for wrong answer, scratching, tick marks, use of whitener and multiple answer and use of any pencil, pen **other than black ball point pen**, will be awarded no marks. The candidate should use **Black Ball Point Pen** only to fill the OMR Answer Sheets.
- 3.7 Duration of the test will be of Three hours. The medium of the test shall be English only.
- 3.8 No candidate will be allowed to appear for Pre-PG-DMAT -2010 unless he/she holds valid admit card issued by the APDMC.

NOTE: - The Association reserves the right to add the Test Centres.

3.9 DEFECTIVE QUESTIONS, THEIR CANCELLATION AND AWARDS OF MARKS IN LIEU OF CANCELLED QUESTIONS

- (i) Wrong structuring.
- (ii) More than one option being correct.
- (iii) None of the option being correct.
- (iv) Any printing error leading to a situation where more than one answer may be correct or none of the answer may be correct.

In lieu of the cancelled questions, every candidate will be awarded extra marks in proportion to the marks obtained by him, irrespective of the fact whether the candidate had attempted such cancelled question or not.

The answers prepared by the subject experts shall be final and binding.

In case the application form has been downloaded from website it shall be submitted alongwith Demand Draft of **Rs. 2500/-** (Cost of application form and examination fee in favour of APDMC, payable at Bhopal).

Application Form can also be obtained from above centres by post by remitting a D.D of **Rs. 1600/-** (including postal charges).

- 4.2 Filled in Application Forms should be submitted on or before **20/02/2010** at the office of Association of Private Dental and Medical Colleges of Madhya Pradesh, DMAT Office E-2/51 Arera Colony Bhopal, either personally or by Post/Courier **with Examination fee of Rs. 1000/-** through a Demand Draft drawn in favour of APDMC, payable at Bhopal.

5. ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1 The candidate must have passed BDS/MBBS course from any of the recognized Dental/Medical College in India.
- 5.2 Candidate must have completed compulsory rotating internship from an institution recognized by the Dental Council of India/ Medical Council of India.
- 5.3 Candidate must be registered with the Dental Council of India / Medical Council of India of any State in India.

6. CANDIDATES NOT ELIGIBLE :

- 6.1 Candidates who have not completed internship on or before 31-03-2010.
- 6.2 Candidates who are registered for PG Degree and have not completed the terms.
- 6.3 Candidates who have NOT obtained permanent DCI/MCI State DC/MC registration by the time of submission of application. Except for those who will be completing the internship by 31st March 2010, such candidates will have to submit registration certificate latest by 2nd May 2010.

- (i). **In case Private Colleges other than mentioned above in table who have applied to DCI for academic session 2010-10 or above Colleges have applied for increase of seats get approval, their seats would also be available at the time of admission.**
- (ii). **Admission to Modern Dental College & RC, Indore and People's College of Dental Sciences & RC, Bhopal in MDS and R. D. Gardi Medical College, Ujjain in MD/MS Courses would be available subject to renewal of permission from DCI/MCI & Government of India.**

NRI Seats

15% of the sanctioned seats shall be filled by merit under NRI quota. **Separate Advertisement will be published by concerned Institutions.** If the seats are not filled under NRI quota, then such seats shall be filled as drop out/vacant seats through Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 merit.

In such case the College shall inform the details of vacant seats in writing one week before the Counselling (for admission through Pre-PG-DMAT-2010) to the office of the Admission and Fee Regularity Committee for Professional Institutions (Medical), Shyamla Hills, Bhopal and as well as to APDMC office, so that remaining seats are included in the Counselling.

• **How to Apply:** - The NRI candidates shall apply directly to the Head of the concerned Institution in the application form prescribed by the Institutions. **NRI candidates are not required to appear in Pre- PG-DMAT-2010.**

The screening of the applications shall be done at the institution level. The admission shall be done on as per the merit list prepared on the basis of MBBS/BDS marks from the applications received. If the seats are not filled under NRI quota then such seats shall be filled as drop out / vacant seats through Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 Merit.

8. MARKSHEET

- (i) The candidate will receive the Marksheet by post "UPC" within a week of declaration of results.
- (ii) Marksheet will contain marks obtained by candidate and his merit ranking.
- (iii) Duplicate Marksheet - In case of loss of original Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 Marksheet a duplicate Marksheet can be obtained on making an application on plain paper to the Controller of Examinations alongwith **Rs. 1000/-** in cash or D.D in favour of APDMC, payable at Bhopal.

9. MODE OF SELECTION

(A). On the basis of the marks obtained by candidates in the Pre-PG- DMAT-2010 merit list will be prepared depending upon number of sanctioned seats. Remaining candidates up to a fixed number will be kept in the waiting list.

(B). Counselling

The Association of Private Dental and Medical Colleges of M.P., Bhopal shall conduct the Counselling for admission in accordance with the law laid by Hon'ble Apex Court in case of P.A. Inamdar Vs Government of Maharashtra and others. The Counselling will be conducted under the supervision of Admission Committee on 30/03/2010 (Tentative). The Admission Committee will consist of:-

1. Chairman – An Eminent Academician.
2. One Professor of faculty of Medicine.
3. One Professor of Faculty of Dentistry.
4. Representative of participating Colleges.
5. Controller of Examinations DMAT - Member Secretary.

10. SELECTION PROCEDURE

The allotment to MDS/MD/MS Courses will be done on the basis of the Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 merit list and the course preferences given by the candidate at the time of Counselling.

- 10.1 Canvassing directly or indirectly for the allotment of seats would disqualify the candidate for admission. Influencing the staff by unfair means will lead to cancellation of allotted seat and such candidate will also face disqualification for appearance in the subsequent Pre-PG-DMAT-2010 Examination.
- 10.2 Candidate selected for admission shall be subject to disciplinary rules of Devi Ahilya Bai Vishwavidhyalaya / Barkatullahah Vishwavidhyalaya / Vikram Vishwavidhyalaya / DCI/MCI Institution/Government of M.P. and Management.
- 10.3 A candidate selected for any MDS/MD/MS Course speciality as merit will not be allowed to change the speciality.
- 10.4 The selection made by the Admission Committee is final and will be binding on the candidates.
- 10.5 Admission to the candidate will be given after the candidate deposits all his/her relevant original certificates, documents alongwith tuition and other fees to the concerned college.
- 10.6 **Documents to be produce at the time of admission:-**
 1. Photocopy of filled in OMR Application Form.
 2. Original Degree of BDS / MBBS Examination.
 3. Certificate regarding compulsory rotating internship from an institution recognized by the Dental Council of India/Medical Council of India.
 4. Certificate of registration with Dental Council of India /Medical Council of India of any State in India.
 5. Statement of marks obtained in Pre-PG-DMAT-2010.
 6. Passing Certificate of High School Certificate or equivalent examinations.
 7. Medical Fitness Certificate.
 8. Declaration Form.
 9. Four recent passport size photographs.
 10. Bond / Bank Guarantee if required by institution.

11. ADMISSION AGAINST VACANCIES ARISING DUE TO ANY REASON

- 11.1 The vacant seats shall be filled by the college based on merit from waiting list of Pre-PG-DMAT -2010.
- 11.2 A candidate who is selected as per his/her merit but does not join the allotted course or cancel the admission after joining, will not be eligible for further selection. **Fees paid shall not be returned back to the candidate.**

12. DISQUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION

Any candidates himself or his authorized proxy if found obstructing the admission process or creating nuisance, shall be liable for disqualification for the admission process. The decision taken by the Admission Committee shall be final and binding.

13.3. The candidate shall be admitted on payment of one year fees at the time of admission in the college. If the college feels that any particular student may leave in midstream then the college may require the candidate either to pay fees for full course and or submit Bond of the fees for whole course, in abidance to the Law laid by the Hon'ble Apex Court in case of Islamic Academy of Education.

14. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING COMPUTERIZED OMR APPLICATION FORM

Note: Form should be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting

It is suggested that candidate make a photocopy of the form and use that for practice.

Please fill the form with great care, **request for corrections will not be entertained at any stage, incompletely filled application form will be rejected without any notice.** Candidates should read all the instructions carefully and fill the form with utmost clarity. They should **use black ball pen only** to write in the boxes and to darken the circles in the columns/lines provided.

14.1 **Name of the Candidate:** Write first name, then middle name (abbreviate if necessary) and then surname in the boxes provided on top of the circles. Leave a box blank between first, second and surname. Darken the corresponding circles with Black Ball Pen

14.2 **Sex:** Write **Male** or **Female** in the box provided and darken the appropriate circle.

14.3 **Date of Birth of Candidate:** In the first column two boxes are provided, write the date in that boxes. Thereafter one box is provided. Write the month (January as Jan) and darken the corresponding circle. In the third column two boxes are given. Write the year (if born in year 1981 write 8 and 1) in the boxes and darken the corresponding circles.

14.4 A recent colour high contrast 3.5 cm. x 4.5 cm. size photograph is required. Only photograph of the front profile with full face, head, shoulder and with both ears visible and taken without wearing any cap or hat or sunglasses, will only be accepted. Polaroid photo is NOT acceptable. Photograph MUST be taken on or after **1st January, 2010** with a placard indicating the name of the candidate (as in the application form) and the date of taking photograph.

In case name and date are written on the photograph after taking it, the application will be rejected.

The name and date on the photograph must be clear and legible.

Photograph should be pasted in such a manner that full profile or head, face and shoulder lies entirely inside the box and no where else. **Do not use pin/staple to fix the photograph. It is not necessary to attest or sign the photograph.**

- 14.5 Mailing address should be clearly written entirely inside the box. Write your name, followed by the address and finally PIN code with contact numbers.
- 14.6. Write name and address in capital letters only.
- 14.7 Signature should be made by the Candidate himself/herself entirely inside the box.
- 14.8 If you have contact phone numbers please fill in the boxes.
- 14.9 **Name of Parent/Guardian:** Write first name, then middle name (abbreviate if necessary) then surname in the boxes provided. **Leave a box blank between names.** Darken the corresponding circles.
- 14.10 **Thumb Impression:** - Apply your left thumb impression using **RED STAM PAD INK** in the space provided in application form. Allow the ink to get complete dry.

NOTE:

- (a) All the particulars in the OMR Application Form must be written carefully and legibly by the candidate in his/her own hand writing.
- (b) Any attempt on the part of a candidate to influence the authorities, directly or indirectly will be treated as disqualification of candidature for admission to MDS/MD/MS courses.
- (c) The candidates are advised to keep the photocopy of OMR application form (of both sides) If any candidate demands the photocopy of OMR application form it will be provided by DMAT office on payments of Rs.200/-

15. ADMIT CARD

Candidate will receive the Admit Card by UPC (under postal certificate) In case the candidates does not receive Admit Card by **23/02/2010** then he/she should collect the Admit Card from the office of Examination Centre Superintendent, Indore latest a day before the examination or he/she should download the copy of the Admit Card from the official website of Association, **www.mpapdmc.com** using the six digit OMR Application Form Number.

- 15.1 Please note that the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the test if he/she does not posses the Admit Card.
- 15.2 The candidate is advised to preserve the Admit Card for all future reference and correspondence.

16. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

The student while studying in the MDS/MD/MS Courses if found indulging in anti college/anti national activities, unlawful activities or ragging in any form contrary to the provision of Act and Law and Law enforced by Government, will be liable to be expelled from the college by the Dean/Principal of the College.

16. (a). Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statements in the application form and/or suppression of any information is liable for disqualification of the candidate, even at later date. Such a candidate will be debarred from the entire selection process and pursuing the course of studies.
16. (b). It is the responsibility of every candidate to submit proper documents. Any attempt to submit documents which are not genuine, will lead to cancellation of the admission of the candidate, forfeiture of the fees, deposits and expulsion of the candidate by the college authorities. The names of such candidates shall be deleted from the Merit List.

16. (c). Pursuant to the orders is W.P (Civil) No. 615 of 1999, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed the Department of Human Resources Development and Education, Govt. of India, to take all necessary steps to curb the menace of ragging and take severe action against the student involved in such activities. Students are expected to take serious note of it.
16. (d). As per the provisions of "Madhya Pradesh prohibition of Ragging Act of 1999", students indulging in ragging can be punished under the Act, resulting in suspension, expulsion from the college and imprisonment.
16. (e). Any issue not dealt herein above will be dealt with and be finally decided by the College.

17. JURISDICTION

In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction shall be State of Madhya Pradesh.
